Pre-requisites	Understands spoken & written English. Have basic numeracy skills. Has a minimum of 12 months prior experience of traffic management works on high motorways and dual carriageways.
Course Aims	To provide candidates with the necessary knowledge to become a Traffic Safety Control Officer.
Course Objectives	At the end of the course, learners will be able to: <ul style="list-style-type: none">➤ assess whether the contractors have the necessary resources to complete the task in the allotted time period to the required standard➤ assess whether the traffic management has been installed correctly to the drawings and the contract requirements➤ assess whether the traffic management will be sufficient to enable the construction work to be carried out safely within it and maintain safety zones➤ Understand the role of a TSCO, and its limitations➤ organise an emergency lane closure within the works area➤ complete a roadspace application for a basic closure.
Certification	Learners pass the course by scoring a minimum of 75% in the end of course written test. Successful candidates will receive a Lantra Awards certificate. NB: If you hold the following qualifications also you can apply for a TSCO card; <ul style="list-style-type: none">➤ 12A Foreman Course certificate or skills card➤ 3 day First Aid at Work qualification➤ Recognised 1 day health & safety training course (or higher qualification)
